



## Endeavour Ipswich Basketball 100 Club – Purpose, Approach & Rules

### (Small Society Lottery LA0173)

#### Purpose

The purpose of the 100 Club is to raise regular funds for Endeavour Ipswich Basketball Club, as a whole, for the ongoing running of the club to enable it to continue offering basketball opportunities to youngsters and adults in the area.

What is a 100 club? It's a monthly lottery club with a chance to win a cash prize.

People are invited to purchase a membership number which entitles them to take part in a monthly prize draw where a winner will be selected randomly and paid the associated winning cash amount.

A proportion of the membership fees (60%) goes to the club and the rest (40%) is allocated to the prize fund, which makes it an attractive way for members to help the club whilst also having an opportunity to win a cash prize each month.

#### Approach & Rules

1	<b>DURATION</b> - The Endeavour Ipswich Basketball 100 Club will run for a 12-month period from March of one year to February of the next with a draw taking place each month.
2	<b>COST</b> - For each yearly payment of £30 (which works out at £2.50 per month) you will be allocated one number between 1-100. A single member can make multiple payments and each will be allocated a dedicated number.
3	<b>PAYMENT PERIOD</b> - Payment for a number must be made in advance for the full 12-month period. There will be no refunds once the money is paid.
4	<b>MEMBERSHIP FORM &amp; PAYMENT METHOD</b> – A google membership/registration form will need to be completed by all new applicants and a one-off payment of £30 for each number allocated will need to be paid no later than 13 <sup>th</sup> March each year. Contact details collected will be held in-line with the club's GDPR & privacy guidelines.
5	<b>NUMBER CONFIRMATION</b> - Once payment is received you will be allocated a number (or numbers if applying for more than 1) which will be communicated

	to you by email along with a printable membership ticket. You are then a member of the 100 club.
6	<b>NUMBER AND AMOUNTS OF PRIZES PER MONTH</b> – For a fully populated 100 club, 2 prize-winning numbers will be drawn randomly each month. The first drawn will win £70 and the second £30. (See below covering the situation when operating below 100 members). All eligible numbers will be entered into each monthly draw irrespective of previous wins.
7	<b>PRIZES WHEN OPERATING BELOW 100</b> - If numbers sold are below 100 the club will run at whatever number necessary based on the level of numbers sold. If 80 numbers are sold the club will be an 80 club. The 2 prizes will be 70% and 30% of the monthly prize fund available. For example, at 80 numbers sold, the first drawn number will receive £56 and the second £24.
8	<b>DRAW TIMING</b> - During the basketball season (Sept – April) a draw will be made at Copleston no later than the 20 <sup>th</sup> of each month either at a Senior Women’s training session or Saturday/Sunday home fixtures. Out of season May/June/July the draw will be made at Copleston Sports Centre no later than the 20 <sup>th</sup> of the month. During August the draw will be made off-site with 2 members of EIBC present, 1 to draw the number and 1 to witness.
9	<b>WINNER NOTIFICATION</b> - The owner of the winning number will be notified via email and/or mobile phone message/call and paid via BACS or cash whichever they prefer.
10	<b>UNCLAIMED WINNINGS</b> - If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into the club funds after six months.
11	<b>MEMBERSHIP</b> - The 100 club will be run as a small society lottery and is open to anyone wishing to support the club (members, family, friends, businesses) and is <b>NOT</b> restricted to members of the club.
12	<b>AGE RESTRICTIONS</b> - Members must be aged 16 or over.
13	<b>CO-ORDINATION</b> - The 100 club will be co-ordinated by parents of the senior women’s team who will act as a sub-committee to the main committee, collecting and managing monies, managing communication, running the draw and ensuring payment is made to winners. In the case of any dispute the decision of the chairman Nick Newman is final. Any queries should be directed to Avril Gray – <a href="mailto:ibc100club@gmail.com">ibc100club@gmail.com</a>
14	<b>GENERAL PUBLICITY</b> - The 100 Club will be publicised via the club’s what’s app groups, Spond, newsletters, social media and on the website
15	<b>LICENSING</b> – Ipswich Basketball Club is registered with Ipswich Borough Council for Small Society Lotteries LA0173. This allows membership to be held by both members & non-members of Ipswich Basketball Club.
16	<b>ONGOING MEMBERSHIP</b> - Towards the close of the 12-month period each owner of a number will be given 2 weeks to decide whether they wish to continue for the following 12-month period.
17	<b>100 CLUB EXPANSION</b> – should there be enough interest the club reserves the right to expand the club beyond 100 to meet the demand. At this point the number of prizes may be increased.
18	<b>LATE ENTRIES</b> – anyone who joins part-way through the year will pay a pro-rata of the annual amount but must be paid up before the 13 <sup>th</sup> day of the month which they wish to take part in.
